

## **Useful Information for the skiers/boarders!**

### **SKI PASS**

Can be obtained from the Tourist Information (across the road).....open 1400 – 1900 for ski passes.

We found it closed in the morning, therefore if you do not arrive to get your ski pass at night then you can get it at the cable car station in the morning. (Just get the ski bus there)

Photo is required at the cable car station (to make life easier!). If you get your pass at the tourist info they will take your photo. If you are getting a few passes then it is easier for one person to go with everybody's money and photos!

**REMEMBER** to ask for the ski bus on your ski pass (1 Euro/day) – again it just makes life easier when getting on/off the bus

The "Mont-Blanc Evasion" pass covers 500kms of piste and works out at 159 euros for 6 days

### **SKI BUS**

Go across the road from the apartments, down the steps cross another road and you will see the ski bus stop there!

Buses start at 0830 and are supposed to be every 10 minutes up until 1030 and then every 20 minutes. We have found that there is a bus at 0855 and then the next one is about 30 minutes after that one and then every 10 minutes again. (Think he must go for breakfast during this gap!!!)

### **SKI HIRE**

We have arranged a 10% discount with Intersport on production of the discount card, which is kept in the apartment. (Please leave there so other people can benefit from it).

There are 2 Intersport shops:

One in St.Gervais village.....(Go down the steps and turn left, it is on the corner)

The other is at Le Bettex (this is where you get the cable car to). They close at 1900.

If you get your ski hire from Intersport you can leave your boots and skis at Le Bettex. They have free lockers for their customers (one disadvantage; there are 97 steps to the lockers but our friends said that this was better than getting the bus with boots and skis!)

## SKI SCHOOL

Can be booked at the tourist information in St.Gervais or in Le Bettex near the cable car. They do groups or private tuition – one to one or small groups

Group lessons are from 1000 – 1230 Jan, Feb, March and April and the times of the afternoon session vary depending on the month.

## PIZZA

There are 2 restaurants that outside the apartments, left at the tourist info and a few yards up the road serving excellent pizzas but it does get very busy so it is advisable to book.

If you fancy a takeaway pizza there is one towards the cable car on the right.

Golden restaurant (go to the church, sharp right turn and then left through a gate – it looks like you are going in to somebody's garden) although a little more expensive than some of the other restaurants their food is also excellent.

## PÂTISSERIE

Opens at 0500 – good for your French bread for the slopes!

## BAR

The local drink is the "Le Grange" (turn left outside the apartments, cross the road and go past the tourist info, turn right and it is on the right). If there is no one in the bar after about 2150 he will close it. (Don't just to stay in there!!)

If you want a late bar then there is something going on in the Yuk a Tan (opposite the cable car, which is approximately a 10 minute walk across the bridge). They usually have a party night on a Saturday and a live band on a Friday.

Another late bar (turn right outside the apartments, just left, cross the road and go past the Escapade building, keep going for a few hundred yards and there is a bar on the left which is good for good and very cheap.
